JONAH 3

Read Jonah 3:1–4 and discuss 1–2 of these questions:

- Share a time you were nervous/scared to do something you knew God wanted you to do.
- How has God used your obedience to him to impact the lives of others?

Read Jonah 3:5–9 and discuss 1–2 of these questions:

- Since they weren't followers of God, why do you think the Ninevites believed God and his message through Jonah?
- How is your faith in God evident through your actions?
- What do you think happens when our words about following Jesus don't match up with our actions?

Read Jonah 3:10 and discuss 1–2 of these questions:

- If God is willing to give forgiveness to anyone who wants it, what does that mean for us?
- Who in your life do you need to forgive or seek forgiveness from?



CONNECTION

- Is it possible for someone to be so sinful that God refuses to forgive them?

MARK OF A DISCIPLE

APPLY IT

What steps can you take this week to be more forgiving of those around you who may or may not ask for forgiveness?
