LUKE 8:26–39

Read Luke 8:26–30 and discuss 1–2 of these questions:

- What about your spiritual journey are you most thankful for?
- What about your spiritual journey do you wish you could have changed?
- If all we knew about Satan and demons was what we see in this passage, what would we know?
- If all we knew about Jesus was what we see in this passage, what would we know?

Read Luke 8:31–33 and discuss 1–2 of these questions:

- Why do you think we, as Christ-followers, might put off going after those who are disconnected or lost?
- What do you imagine life was like for the man before and after he was set free by Jesus?
- If that man asked you what his next step should be, what advice would you give him?

Read Luke 8:34–39 and discuss 1–2 of these questions:

- When was a time you experienced Jesus working in your life?
- What would it take for you to become more willing to share about Jesus with others, even if it was just you being open about your own experiences with him or what he's teaching you?



CONNECTION

- In what ways do you sense people around you might seem “stuck” spiritually or in some other way, keeping them from seeing Jesus?

MARK OF A DISCIPLE

APPLY IT

How can you be an example of Jesus this week to those at your school who most people think of as “outsiders”?

Be specific:

- What are you going to do?

- When are you going to do it?
